2010 Bible Reading Calendar*

Including daily readings covering the whole Bible in one year

The Bible reading plan found in this calendar is thematic in approach. The idea is to make as many connections as possible between different parts of the Bible, while still reading individual books from start to finish. Only the Psalms are not read through consecutively; instead, they are apportioned throughout the year. Many of the Psalms (although not all) contribute something to the other reading or readings for the day. A few examples:

Jan 1 Gen 1:26 and Psalm 8:4-8: man is given dominion over the animals; Col 1:15-16, Christ is active in creation

Jan 8 Gen 15:6 and Rom 4:3: Abraham's faith is credited to him as righteousness

Jan 30 Ex 14, Psa 114:3, and 1 Cor 10:1: crossing the sea

Feb 8 Ex 34 and 2 Cor 3:7-13: Moses' shining face veiled

Feb 19 Lev 19:2 and 1 Pet 1:16 – you shall be holy, for I am holy

Mar 25 Psa 131 and Matt 18:1-4: child-like faith

Apr 5 Psa 37:4 (“delight yourself in the Lord”) with suggestions for how to do this in Isaiah 58

Apr 15 Num 14 and Heb 3:16-19: Israelite unbelief leads to their dying in the wilderness

May 23 Pentecost readings – Joel 2:28-32 and Acts 2:17-21

May 26 The death of Achan in Joshua 7 and the deaths of Ananias and Sapphira in Acts 5 for deceit

July 7 2 Sam. 11 and Psa. 51: David's capital sins and his confession of that sin

July 21 Prov. 7's counsel to stay away from the strange woman, and 1 Ki. 11: Solomon's failure to follow his own advice, and the pain that followed

July 28 Elijah's mention in both James 5 and 1 Kings 18

Aug 16 2 Kings 4 and Mark 6: the ministries of Elijah and Christ marked by both healing and feeding

Aug 20 Nahum (judgment on Nineveh, the capital of Assyria) with 2 Kings 19's disaster for the Assyrian army and the assassination of the Assyrian king at Nineveh

Oct 31 Hab 2:4 and Gal 3:11 on Reformation Sunday: the just shall live by faith

Dec 24 Esther 9:20-22 on Christmas Eve. This passage in Esther is used as the basis for the church's observance of historical events such as Advent (Christmas)

There are many other connections to be found in this Bible reading plan, but these should be enough to demonstrate the desired aim. Although this plan is meant to be read in one year, do not be discouraged if you fall behind. The main reason for this and other Bible reading plans is to encourage you to feed on the Word of God on a regular basis. However, each person finds himself in different circumstances. One person may have the time, resources, and energy to read the Bible through three times or more in a year; another may need a much longer time frame to cover a single trip.

Reading through the Bible within a certain time frame is not important. What is important is that you progress in your knowledge of God as you prayerfully study His Word.
